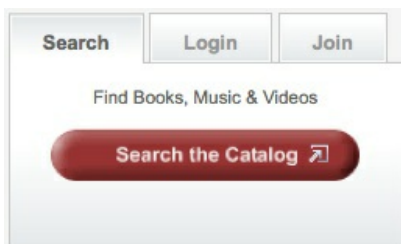


## Access Your Account
