The Library is proud to share the news that Pulitzer Prize-winning author Maureen Dowd will be the 2024 Annual Gala honoree. Dowd has been an Op-Ed columnist for the *New York Times* since 1995 and won the 1999 Pulitzer Prize for distinguished commentary. She has written three best-selling books, including *Bushworld* and *Are Men Necessary? When Sexes Collide*. Her third bestseller, *The Year of Voting Dangerously: The Derangement of American Politics*, was released in 2016 and is available for checkout at the Library.

Born in Washington, D.C., Ms. Dowd began her journalism career in 1974 as an editorial

assistant for the *Washington Star*. In 1983 she joined the *New York Times* as a metropolitan correspondent and then moved to the *Times's* Washington bureau in 1986 to cover politics. Ms. Dowd has covered nine presidential campaigns, served as the *Times's* White House correspondent, and wrote *On Washington*, a column for the *Times Magazine*. Ms. Dowd has also written for *GQ*, *Vanity Fair*, *Rolling Stone*, the *New Republic*, *Mademoiselle*, *Sports Illustrated* and others. Her *New York Times* Opinion column appears every Sunday.
